

PUBLIC PROTECTION AND SAFETY COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Public Protection and Safety Committee was called to order by Chairman Leon on Monday, February 1, 2016, at 6:21 P.M.

Members present: Coenen, Driessen, Leon, and McGinnis.

Members present: Roehrig and Penterman, Atty. Davidson, Mayor Rosin, DPW/Eng. Sundelius, Police Chief Manion, Fire Chief Hirte, Planner Jakel, HR Dir. Vanderloop, Fin. Dir. VanRossum, IT Mgr. Krause, Rec. Dir. Malloy, St. Supt. VandenHeuvel, Eng./GIS Spec. Neumeier, and interested citizens.

1. DPW/Eng. Sundelius explained that with the recent upgrades the Kaukauna Area School District did to its athletic facilities adjacent to Loderbauer Road, the number of athletic events will increase which will result in vehicles parking on the shoulder of Loderbauer Road. Loderbauer Road is a rural roadway that was not designed for parking. The roadway is scheduled for reconstruction in 2017 with concrete pavement and parallel parking on both sides along with public sidewalk. The Kaukauna Police Department and the Kaukauna Area School District are in favor of restricting parking along Loderbauer Road.

Motion by Driessen, seconded by Coenen, to authorize the placement of the necessary signage to restrict parking on both sides of Loderbauer Road from CTH CE southerly to Andrea Michelle Court.

All members voted aye.

Motion carried.

2. DPW/Eng. Sundelius explained that when Taylor Street was reconstructed in 2012, the school bus loading zone on the north side of Taylor Street adjacent to Park School was never changed to reflect the change in the school bus loading zone area.

Motion by Coenen, seconded by McGinnis, to direct the City Attorney to draft the proper ordinance restricting parking for a school bus loading zone on Taylor Street by changing 188 feet to 334 feet west of the curblin on Lawe Street.

All members voted aye.

Motion carried.
