

**FEE SCHEDULE**  
 For The  
**ILLICIT DISCHARGE DETECTION & ELIMINATION PROGRAM**  
**CITY OF KAUKAUNA, WISCONSIN**

**Forfeitures / Fines:**

Forfeitures / fines for the illicit discharge detection and elimination program vary from a minimum of **\$25** to a maximum of **\$500** for each day of non-compliance and each occurrence. Issuance of a forfeiture / fine will depend on if the violator is non-responsive or if the violation is blatant, intentional, repetitive or severe. The forfeitures / fines are as follows:

Notice of Violation	Home Owner	Other
Failure to properly dispose of a pollutant or illicit discharge	<b>\$50</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Failure to take reasonable actions to eliminate an illicit discharge	<b>\$50</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Failure to take reasonable actions to locate an undocumented drain	<b>\$30</b>	<b>\$300</b>
Failure to implement WPDES Industrial Discharge Permit	<b>n/a</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Failure to allow reasonable access for inspecting or sampling	<b>\$50</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Failure to install, maintain or calibrate monitoring equipment	<b>n/a</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Failure to install or maintain non-structural and structural BMPs	<b>n/a</b>	<b>\$500</b>
Failure to notify City of a spill or release of hazardous substance	<b>\$25</b>	<b>\$250</b>
Failure to take reasonable actions to prevent or contain a spill or release of a hazardous substance	<b>\$50</b>	<b>\$500</b>

Mandatory training workshops and/or community service projects (e.g. stream cleanup, highway cleanup, etc.) could also be used to encourage behavior change if a violation is blatant, intentional, non-responsive, repetitive, or severe.
