**Comments/Suggestions:**

1. Love all these ideas! Especially in-water play ideas for littles!
2. When adding items into the pool make sure there is not too much stuff that there are not good sight lines. When you have children of all ages you need to be able to see them in all areas of the pool. Add as much as needed without raising the entry fee too much.
3. If the flooring in the public and staff locker rooms are being renovated, the drains should be indented into the ground more so water pours into the drains easier without so many wet spots.
4. The more room to spread out around the pool/splash pad the better.
5. If Kaukauna Pool added more in water features like a playground, splash pad and shallow area just for tots to play... It would keep us in Kaukauna rather than venturing out to Oshkosh or other splash pad parks. Also a must for parents to be able to get shade and have an area for snacks and lunch under shade.
6. Possibly paint fun aquamarine life at bottom of pools/splash pad area. \*Use bright colors!
7. Lazy River Without water splashing on you! Check out or go to Pollock Water Park, Erb Park and Sherwood Splash Pad. Seymour Slash Pad.
