

ORDINANCE 2021-1835
ORDINANCE AMENDING INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT
COMMISSION IN CH. 1, SEC. 1.33 IN THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, to protect and preserve future land use in the City of Kaukauna's Industrial and Business Park network, the Common Council amends Chapter 1, Section 1.33 to allow for a minority of Commissioners to represent non-resident owners and employees of Industrial Park and Business Park businesses; and


WHEREAS, the matter was referred to, acted upon, and recommended for approval by the Legislative Committee on May 4, 2021; and


WHEREAS, after due notice as required by law, a public hearing was held before the Common Council on July 20, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Kaukauna do ordain that Chapter 1, Section 1.33 of the Kaukauna Municipal Code shall be stricken and shall be replaced with the following:

- (1) Composition: The development, promotion and sale of the city industrial park is under the direction of the city industrial and commercial development commission which consists of nine citizen members, who shall be residents of the city or non-resident commissioners who are owners or employees of industrial and business park businesses within the City. Not less than half such commissioners shall be residents of the city.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.
