

ORDINANCE 2021-1836
ORDINANCE AMENDING ANIMALS; PROHIBITED AREAS FOR ANIMALS IN CH. 9.15 (6)
IN THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the 2019 Parks and Open Space Plan adopted by this body identified a wide public desire for allowing leashed dogs in select City parks; and

WHEREAS, the matter was referred to, acted upon, and recommended for approval by the City Plan Commission on May 21, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the proposed ordinance change was reviewed and was recommended for approval by the Legislative Committee on June 14, 2021; and

WHEREAS, after due notice as required by law, a public hearing was held before the Common Council on July 20, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Common Council of the City of Kaukauna do ordain that Section 9.15(6) of the Kaukauna Municipal Code shall be stricken and shall be replaced with the following:


9.15 – Animals

(6) Prohibited Areas for Animals.

Leashed dogs are permitted in select municipal parks, including: Central Park, Fassbender Park, Kelso Park, Konkapot Preserve, Nature View Park, Quarry Point Park, Rapid Croche Park, Thilwerth Park, Van Eperen Park, and on the following trails: Fox Heritage Trail, Konkapot Trail, Nelson Family Heritage Crossing Trail, and Travis Dercks Memorial Trail. Off-leash dogs are permitted in the City of Kaukauna Dog Park only. Any person owning, keeping or in charge of any animal shall not permit such animal to be in any other public park in the City at any time, except as authorized in writing by the park department. The provisions of this section shall not be applicable in cases in which a person is being assisted by a service animal.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication.
