The Kaukauna Farmer's Market welcomes the youth of the community to participate in the Market!

The Market offers one "Youth Booth" stall during the season. It is a vendor stall that may be occupied by an individual child or youth group that would like to sell handmade items or would like to raise money for an organization. Space is allocated on a first come, first serve basis to qualified non-profits. Qualified non-profits may participate once per Market season.

Non-Profits are allowed to have an information booth to hand out materials to inform patrons about their organization. They also are permitted to sell items if they are directly related to their non-profit. Items to be sold must be approved by management.

- Market Hours are 7:30 am – Noon.
- There will be a charge of \$8.00 for this vendor space.
- Booth space is approximately 10' x 10'.
- Non-profits must be approved prior to setting up.
- Non-profits must engage children.
- Non-profits must abide by all vendor guidelines including set-up, clean-up and controlling tents.
